Additional Information

Cell Phones and Stereos

You may bring along a personal stereo or a cell phone, but it is only for use **free time**, *not* program time or meals. We will ask that you keep all valuables in the cabin. Keep in mind that camp will not be responsible if you lose it or if it is taken. **Parents, please know that your child will only be able to receive and answer calls during limited free time, or in the late evening. If there is an emergency, please call the emergency number above.**

Food and Snacks

You may also bring along some snack food, but please be reasonable. We will be feeding you plenty. Snack food must be left in the cabin at all times. Absolutely no eating in sleeping areas.

Clothing

Remember to pack plenty of warm clothing that can get dirty; you need to be prepared for the weather and we will be outside most of both days. Remember this is not a fashion show.

Money

There is little to spend money on **except** for the soda machine. A few dollar bills or some change is all that might be needed. Do not bring \$5, \$10, \$20 bills as there is no way to make change at camp.

Cabins

The boys will be in a separate sleeping area from the girls. Teachers and chaperones will be with each group.

Behavior

This is a school-sponsored trip. Students are expected to behave in a safe and respectful manner. Smoking is not allowed. Environmental or property damage will be noted and students will be billed accordingly. Fighting, cursing, and other disregard of the ground rules set forth by trip leaders will not be tolerated. Students whose behavior is deemed by trip leaders to be unacceptable will call home and a parent or guardian will be required to pick them up at camp regardless of the time..
