With four family centers throughout Chicagoland, JCYS welcomes families of all faiths and backgrounds into a warm, inclusive community where little ones, starting at 6 weeks old, are known, loved, and celebrated.

Our play-based, Reggio-inspired approach builds confidence and imagination. Each day, children live Jewish values like tikkun olam (repairing the world), tzedakah (giving and justice), and chesed (loving kindness) through lessons, connection, and purposeful play.

We care for the whole child: helping them develop emotional intelligence, strong problem-solving skills, healthy bodies, and a lifelong love of learning—tools that stick with them far beyond preschool.


