

# JCYS RESPIRATORY VIRUS NOTIFICATION, ISOLATION & TESTING PROTOCOLS

JEWISH COUNCIL FOR YOUTH SERVICES The following steps will be taken in the event of a positive case within a JCYS facility:

## 1. INFORM

Parent/Employee informs Center Director/supervisor of positive test result

## 2. CONNECT

• Center Director informs Managing Director of Operations and Director of Risk Management by including them in the classroom Kaymbu distribution.

## 3. IDENTIFY

• Center Director will determine close contacts of the individual who has tested positive for, or has a presumed, respiratory virus.

## 4. ISOLATE POSITIVE CASES

- Individuals who have confirmed/presumed respiratory virus must stay home and isolate until symptoms improve and they have been fever free, without the use of fever-reducing medicine, for a minimum of 24 hours.
- Individuals returning after being fever free must be able to engage in classroom activities without symptoms impeding their ability to participate.
- Masking is encouraged for 5 days upon return if the individual is over age 2.

## 5. NOTIFY

• Center Director will notify the classroom of the individual who has tested positive for, or has a presumed, respiratory virus.
